

Job Title: **Production Helper**

Job Description:

Assists workers engaged in fabrication of structural or sheet metal products, performing any combination of following tasks.

Duties:

Performs some or all of the following:

1. Lifts, positions, and removes workpieces from machines to assist in fitting and welding..
2. Holds tape and rods and marks reference points to assist in layout.
3. Loads, stacks, and transports stock, tools, dies, and work in process by hand or forklift.
4. Attaches grappling equipment to workpieces to prepare workpiece for moving by crane or jib.
5. Cleans and scrapes metal preparatory to fabricating, welding, painting, or shipping, using scraping tool, abrasive, or placing in solvent bath.
6. Picks up and trucks scrap from work areas.
7. Performs other duties as may be assigned by the Production Supervisor within the limits of HELPER duties.

Education: Vocational or technical training.

Credentials: Canadian Welding Bureau (CWB) Certificate or equivalent (Preferred but not necessary).

Type of Equipment: Familiarity with how Brakes and presses, Cutting torches, Grinders, Drills and forklifts work.

Area of Specialization: Structural metal or steel.

Major Work Area: Fabrication, Assembly, Fitting, Shipping.

Specific Skills: Familiarity with how brakes and presses, cutting torches, grinders, drills and forklifts works. Knowledge of skidding, sticking parts/member identification stickers or otherwise preparing customer product for shipment.

Essential Skills: Working with others, Problem Solving, Critical Thinking, Job task planning and organizing, Significant use of memory, Finding information and continuous learning.
